	SUBJECT: Acting Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Technician Positions		

The Fire and Rescue Department currently has vacancies at the rank of EMS Technician and is soliciting personnel to fill these positions until a new list is established.

Personnel interested in an acting EMS Technician position must have two years of time-in-service (from the date of recruit graduation) and be an authorized Advanced Life Support (ALS) provider.

Personnel who meet these requirements shall be considered in the order of seniority of time-in-service and seniority in length of time as a county authorized ALS provider.

Personnel interested in an acting position shall submit a letter of interest to Battalion Chief Carlton G. Burkhammer via email at carlton.burkhammer@fairfaxcounty.gov by the close of business on April 18, 2008. The letter of interest should contain your date of recruit graduation and the date you became an authorized ALS provider. The letter of interest must be submitted as an attachment in an email.
